HOW IT WORKS

Ultrasonic cleaning uses cavitation bubbles induced by high frequency pressure (sound) waves to agitate a liquid. The agitation produces high forces on contaminants adhering to the fruits and vegetables. This action also penetrates blind holes, cracks, and recesses. The intention is to thoroughly remove all traces of contamination tightly adhering or embedded onto solid surfaces

The sterilization effect of ultrasonic waves is mainly caused by the cavitation effect it produces, which leads to the metabolic disorder and death of some bacteria in the liquid, the inactivation of viruses, and even the destruction of the cell walls of some small microorganisms.

Safely clean fruits and vegetables, even meat and eggs, without chemicals. Destroys up to 94% of microbes and pesticide residues

Cavitation: A phenomenon in which the static pressure of the liquid reduces to below the liquid's vapour pressure, leading to the formation of small vapor-filled cavities in the liquid




- 5. When the countdown time on the display screen is "00:00", the machine will return to standby state after 5 beeps.
- 6. After cleaning, unplug from electrical outlet, open the cover, take out the basket/bag and your cleaned items. With the drain hose attached to the unit and the other end in a sink or bucket, remove the drain cover inside the cleaning tank, release the dirty water, wipe dry the cleaning tank, close the drain cover and store in a cool dry place with all accessories inside the basin.



NOTE:

- 1. This product does not affect wax on articles.
- 2. Do not start the machine without adding water, otherwise it may damage the machine or seriously affect the life of the machine.
- 3. Fresh eggs can be cleaned by using the "fruits" mode and cleaning for 8 minutes

A short power-supply cord (or short detachable power-supply cord) is provided to reduce the risks resulting from becoming entangled in or tripping over a longer cord. Extension cords (or longer detachable power-supply cords) are available and are not prohibited from being used when care is exercised in their use.

When an extension cord is used:

The marked electrical rating of the detachable power-supply cord or extension cord shall be no less than the marked electrical rating of the product; When the product is of the grounded type, the extension cord shall be a grounding-type 3-wire cord; and the longer cord shall be arranged so that it does not drape over the counter-top or tabletop where it is capable of being tripped over, snagged, or pulled on unintentionally, especially by children.

OPERATION PANEL INSTURCTIONS

- 1. Plug in the power; the machine will beep one long beep, and the display screen and all LED lights will light up at the same time. After 1 second, it will enter the standby state. In the standby state, the indicator lights of "vegetable -fruit -grain -meat -shrimp, crab and shellfish -seafood -bottle -custom" will remain on, "on/off" will blink, "ultrasonic" and "water circulation" will be unlit.
- 2. Press the "Select" button; 8 functions of "vegetable, fruit, grain, meat and bone, shrimp, crab and shellfish, seafood, baby bottle, custom" can be selected in a circular way. The corresponding function indicator light is on, while the other unselected function indicator lights are off. Each function has a corresponding default working time display.
- 3. When selecting the "Customize" function, the time flashes. You can adjust the working time of the program by pressing the "</>" buttons above the "+" and "-". When "customize" is chosen the machine will work just the ultrasonic function.
- 4. When the machine is in standby, pressing "ultrasonic" will allow for "ultrasonic" cleaning alone, and the same for "water circulation", it can be pressed when in standby to only circulate the water. Each function can be used separately and has a default time of 5:00 minutes, which can be adjusted by using the "</>" buttons above the "+" and "-" indicators.
- 5. Under working conditions, press the "on/off" button. The indicator light of the "on/off" button will blink and the machine will stop working.
- 6. The "Select" button inactive when the machine is in use. To change functions the machine must be in standby state.
- 7. When the countdown time is completed, the display will read "00:00," the machine will beep 5 times, and it return to standby state.
- 8. Select the function and time, then click the "on/off" button to turn the machine on. The "on/off" button indicator light illuminates, the machine starts, and the timer countdown begins.

MACHINE OPERATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Place the machine on a flat sturdy surface, open the cover of the machine, put the drain cover inside the cleaning tank into the drain hole, and press it in place to ensure that it is in tightly. Then insert the drain pipe into the drainage nozzle behind the machine, and place the outlet of the drain pipe in a sink or bucket.
- Insert the AC connector of the power cord into the AC socket at the back of the machine. Plug the power cord into the AC120V grounded power outlet.




3. Open the cover of the machine and put the items to be cleaned into the basket. (Or, remove the basket, place items in the basket, and then put the basket back into the machine.) Place the basket lid on top to hold produce under the water. Add tap water to the basin, keeping the water level between the "lowest" and "highest" lines that are marked on the back of the basin. Ensure that the items being cleaned are completely immersed. Close the top cover.



4. Use the "Select" button to choose from 8 menu items to clean: "vegetables" "fruits" "grains" "meat" "fish and shrimp" "seafood" "milk bottles" "custom". There are 2 other functions ("ultrasonic" and "water circulation") that can be used for custom/singular function selection. Select the item you are cleaning from the menu and then press the "on/off" button; the red indicator light will be on, default time will be displayed and the machine will start working, and the time will count down.

NOTE: When cleaning whole grains or small items, it is recommended to use the special woven bag, which is provided, with zipper closed. Put it into the cleaning tank, select the required function, and then start the machine for cleaning.



D CAUTION (1)

Note: Ultrasonic cleaning function can remove the residue on jewelry and the oxidization on metal parts, but metal parts should be contained into the basket or bag so that they don't hit against the wall of tank directly while in cleaning; otherwise they may scratch the wall of tank.
